



Minutes District 27-B1 Cabinet Meeting Sunday, November 15, 2009 City Center Hotel, Oshkosh, WI

- 1. Call to Order @ 8:50 a.m. by DG Leonard Quinn
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance by PDG Ken Wallander
- 3. **Prayer and Song** by PDG Victor Voigt
- 4. **Approval of Agenda** motion made by PDG Tom King, 2nd by VDGE Merle Strelow Motion Carried
- 5. **Roll Call** taken by CST Gary Colton, 34 cabinet members and 3 district honorary members were present.
- 6. **Approval of Cabinet Minutes** from August 2, 2009 motion made by Lion Dave Holschbach, 2nd by Lion Sandy King. Motion Carried
- 7. **Treasurer's Report** presented by CST Gary Colton. Motion to accept by PDG Victor Voigt, 2nd by Lion Gary Silah. Motion Carried.
- 8. **Tail Twister** Lion Irv Korth reported he collected \$288 during the convention
- 9. **Communications** We received a Thank you letter from the Union Grove Lions for our sponsorship of the Counselor Appreciation Package.
- 10. **Old Business**: None reported.
- 11. New Business:
 - A. Convention Wrap-up PDG Gary Colton gave a recap of the issues this year with the City Center Hotel but reported it all worked out well in the end. Lion Sandy said she was impressed by the great attitude and effort made by the City Center Staff. VDG Jerry Post reported that the comments on the seminars were very positive. PDG Vern Pautz requested a return of the convention evaluation forms for next year. DG Len Quinn commended the committee on a job well done and thank you.
 - B. **Future Convention Dates** A motion was made by PDG Vern Pautz for the committee to widen the window of time if necessary to hold the convention, 2nd by Lion Sandy King. Motion Carried.
- 12. Committee Reports:
 - A. Constitution/Bylaws/Protocol IPDG Gary Bilke no report
 - B. **MERLO** PDG Ed Filemyr reported that PDG John Schwab will be in Waldo to increasing their club membership. There will also be discussion on forming a new club in Oostburg.

- 1. Membership Lion Dennis Schwartz discussed a program he has called "Show Your Colors". He is willing to present to any club upon request.

 - 3. Retention Lion August Grahl
- 4. Leadership VDG Jerry Post stated that clubs are realizing the need to have people step up to the next level.
- 5. Orientation Lion August Grahl is in the process of updating the Orientation book.
- C. **WLF** PDG Tom Clausen gave awards to the zone chairmen. He reported that Since May's report there are 39 clubs that are members of Pride. There was a \$40,000 increase in donations to WLF this year over last. This is the time to think of starting a deer hide collection in your area. The Camp Raffle for Kids made only \$30,000 this year. New fundraisers need to be looked at.
- D. **Affiliate President** Lioness Ella Stanelle has attended several special events and a zone meeting. She has 6 club visitations scheduled. She reported that 37 Lioness attended the District convention representing 9 clubs. Their Basket raffle made \$650.00 and Skirt Twister made \$150.00
 - E. **Affiliate Liaison** Lion Meg Post reported that she is enjoying her job as Liaison.
- F. **Alert Program** Lion Mary Jo Abler indicated a need for a registry from clubs willing to help other clubs in case of an emergency. ALERT is a second or third source of help in a disaster area. Alert is generally not involved with any type of funding. If LCIF funding is requested, VDG Jerry Post is the district's contact person.
- G. **LCIF** PDG Vern Pautz didn't have much to report on LCIF, but did encourage clubs that have the money in LCIF to use it to name a Melvin Jones recipient. He can help with this.
- H. **USA/Canada Leadership Forum** PDG Gary Colton reported that the USA/Canada forum will be held in Milwaukee next year, Sept. 23rd 25th. Wisconsin had 136 members in Memphis at the forum to help with pre-registering 1,268 attendees for Milwaukee. If anyone is interested in volunteering in Milwaukee at the forum contact Gary.
- I. **Lions Pride** PDG Herb Schneider informed anyone who received an IRA rollover letter should contact Lion Dewey Karl. He reported that 255 clubs in the multiple district have contributed to Pride in the amount of \$728,246.16. Total contributions to Pride is \$5.1 million.
- J. Youth Exchange Lion Sandy King reported that she starts to get information in January on the kids coming from overseas. She needs host families and camp counselors for the 3^{rd} week in July. Counselors must be 18-28 years of age.
- K. **Special Olympics** PDG Orv Kittel reported very good reception at their table at the convention. Two clubs asked to have speakers come to their meeting. He also had 60 volunteer sheets picked up by people interested in helping in Oshkosh. Any zone chairman interested in volunteer sheets see Orv.
- L. **Leo Chairman** PDG Ken Wallander reported that 90% of the calendar sales come of District B1. There is very little interest in the other districts.
- M. Peace Poster Lion Dawn Christensen reported that there were 10 entries in the Peace Poster contest this year. Pavxia Vue sponsored by the Sheboygan Noon club designed the winning poster. He will receive a check for \$25 and the poster will be sent on to the State convention.

- O. **Hearing, Speech & Eyeglass Recycling** PDG Paul Tadych had called in to DG Len Quinn that he has 4-5 hearing aid applications that he is working on.

- P. **Lions Eye Bank of WI** PDG Tom King reported they are still working on the Building fund. If a club donates \$500 there are matching funds, so clubs can qualify for a Knight of Sight Fellowship. Transporting is going well and Tom is available to speak to clubs.
- Q. **Mission to Mexico** Lion Sandy King reported their last mission was to Victoria. The club in Mexico paid all of their expenses including the motel. They fitted over 2,800 glasses.

- S. **State Lions Convention** Lion Merl Strelow stated the next meeting date is January 8, 2010. PDG Jordan Chadwick is the new state chairman. They plan on copying A1's district convention format and hopefully get more donations. They need raffle prizes and hole sponsors for golf.
